- a. **April 20, 2017 Meeting Minutes**-A motion was made by Marty Clinch to approve the April 20, 2017 finance committee meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Todd Rice. **Motion passed #1.**

2. **Approval of Journal Entries and Interfund Transfers**

Ann Sasso explained the journal entries since the last finance meeting. Most of the entries were due to the monthly garbage transfer and start fiscal year but there was a transfer made from the garbage street fund to the general fund that the board previously agreed to do.

3. **Discussion and recommendation to the Village Board on the Annual Tax Levy Ordinance for FY 17-18**

Amy Pace discussed the levy proposal. The proposal would be to leave the same corporate rate based on an estimated EAV that was received from Woodford County with a \$9,000 increase in order to fund the restricted use accounts.

A motion was made by Todd Rice to recommend to the Village Board the Annual Tax Levy as proposed in the total amount of \$391,138. The motion was seconded by Marty Clinch. **Motion passed #3.**
