- •Leave grass clippings on lawn use a mulching lawn mower.
- •Sign up for online billing and magazines.
- •Buy products made from recycled content materials.
- •Shop at the farmers markets or grow a garden full of vegetables.
- •Compost.
- •Install a programmable thermostat.
- •Buy energy efficient appliances.
- •Bring a travel mug to your favorite coffee shop.
- •Use compact fluorescent lights (CFLs) or LED light bulbs.
- •Share your green know-how with others.
- •Use a solar charger for your electronics with built-in batteries.
- •Repair a pair of favorite shoes instead of buying new.
- •Get a rain barrell.
- •Wash full loads of laundry in cold or warm water.
- •Maintain your vehicle keep tires properly inflated.
- •Repair leaky faucets.
