A flag pole with the American Flag and possibly the POW flag will be put up along with benches and lights similar to First Responders Park. Rich explained the idea of constructing the sidewalk along Jubilee Lane to connect to sidewalk paths up to the monuments. Rich has an estimate on the sidewalk along Casey's. The committee discussed.

Mike Hinrichsen mentioned the need to have some foliage as the back drop behind the monuments.

Rich Brecklin also explained the possible idea of having a Veterans Park arch indicating the name of the park and that there would also be some landscaping on the property but there wouldn't be much as there is limited space.

Ann Sasso noted CMT had used the drone information to do a mock up of the design that was discussed previously.

Rich Brecklin noted he is getting estimates on electric and concrete. The committee agree to have Rich Brecklin and Dick Hartman discuss the project and bring a recommendation to the board.
