a. July 22, 2021 Meeting Minutes-A motion was made by Jeff DeGroot to approve the July 22, 2021 finance committee meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Todd Rice. Motion passed \#1.
2. Discussion and recommendation to the Village Board on the employment compensation study and potential wage adjustments
Stephanie Chaon noted the personnel committee had made a recommendation to the finance committee based on the employee compensation study to approve the wage adjustments raising the hourly pay for all full-time employees by $\$ 4.00$. The assistant bookkeeper position is already at the recommended pay and receives a benefit package that includes health insurance.
