Nathan noted he, Karl Figg, Zack Hecht and Ann Doubet met with the employees for the annual reviews. The goal every year is to get the reviews and compensation decision completed before May 1<sup>st</sup>, the start of the new fiscal year. Nathan stated they are recommending a 3.29% average increase for the employees.

A motion was made by Karl Figg to recommend to the finance committee employment compensation for FY 25-26 a 3.29% average increase. The motion was seconded by Elizabeth Cunningham. Motion passed #2.

# 6. Discussion and Approval to Recommend the Hiring of a Public Works Maintenance Worker

Nathan Henricks noted the Village received approximately 20 applications for the open public works maintenance position that were reviewed. After interviewing some applicants, Kevin Searle has been selected for the position and is able to start work on May 5th. Kevin goes by Josh.

A motion was made by Karl Figg to recommend the hiring of Kevin (Josh) Searle for the public works maintenance worker position. The motion was seconded by Elizabeth Cunningham. Motion passed #3.
