2. Minutes Approval

a. June 4, 2024-Street Committee Meeting Minutes

A motion was made by Heather Armistead to approve the street committee meeting minutes from June 4, 2025. The motion was seconded by Tom Eckstein. Motion passed #1.

3. Public Comments

Randy Perau asked if there was a plan for rock along the Somerset shoulder on the south side of the road. Randy also asked about the Fandel Road sidewalk.

4. Discussion and Recommendation to the Village Board on the Crosswalk Landing at Rt. 116- and Ten-Mile Creek Rd.

Karl Figg had noticed there are two people with motorized wheelchairs that regularly cross Rt. 116 at Ten Mile Creek Road. The committee discussed that there isn't a crosswalk landing on the south side of Rt. 116 and Ten Mile Creek Road.

Kailey Hindes from CMT explained a proposed crosswalk landing and sidewalk connection along the existing curb and gutter. She noted a 7' minimum sidewalk would need to be built along the edge of the curb to the edge of the road due to the requirements. The committee discussed the proposed plan. The next step is to receive IDOT approval of the plan. Kailey noted the estimated cost is approximately \$23,800.00.

Depending on whether there are IDOT changes, the plan could come back to the street committee or go to the Village Board for approval.

Heather Armistead asked if there could be a warning light for the pedestrians at the crosswalk and asked about the transition to the parking lot.

Ann Doubet noted IDOT is aware the Village is looking at doing a crosswalk landing at this location similar to what was done at Arbor Vitae, and they are supportive.

A motion was made by Tom Eckstein to Recommend to the Village Board the crosswalk landing at Rt. 116 and Ten Mile Creek Rd. and to send the plan to IDOT for review. The motion was seconded by Karl Figg. Motion passed #2.

Kailey will check on the questions concerning the warning light and parking lot transition.

5. **Adjournment**-A motion was made by Karl Figg to adjourn the meeting at 5:35 p.m. The motion was seconded by Tom Eckstein. Motion passed #3.
